IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

This election all voters must show satisfactory proof of their identity and their place of ordinary residence.

Acceptable ID can be Photo ID issued by a government agency with your name and address (ie. driver's licence) or two valid original pieces of authorized identification. (both pieces must have your name and one must also have your address).
